This notice serves as an announcement of the intention of the South African Heritage Resources Agency (SAHRA) to declare two known and authenticated copies of the Freedom Charter signed by the leaders of the first participating organisations involved in the ASSOCIATION OF AFRICAN PEOPLE'S ORGANISATIONS (AAPO) and the National Heritage Resources Act, 1969 (Act No. 25 of 1969) (NHRA) as a Specifically Declared Heritage Object.

SAHRA has identified these copies of the Freedom Charter, after having conducted research into the significance of an original draft, as having qualities so exceptional that they are of special national importance and warrant the most stringent heritage protection afforded by the NHRA. It is recognised that these are authentic copies of the Freedom Charter, including handwritten and dated but unsigned copies. The declaration of the two signed copies is the beginning of a special declaration which will include pre and post adoption documents, including the original draft, and the original and authenticated copies of the Signature Campaign as well as the 25th Anniversary and subsequent by GOASA and UDF. The significance of the Freedom Charter lies in the democratic process involved to document the struggle for the liberation of South Africa, and the role of the various organisations that formed the basis of the struggle (greyed for as well as the Constitution of South Africa. SAHRA signed copies represent the endorsement of the Freedom Charter by the African National Congress, South African Indian Congress, South African Coloured Peoples Organisation, South African Congress of Democrats and the South African Congress of Trade Unions.

Please note that in accordance with the provisions of Section 21 of the NHRA, after declaration of the Freedom Charter, SAHRA will issue a permit for any alterations, restoration, and export of any of the two copies declared. Any alteration could only be made by SAHRA through a written permit of entry and a relevant export permit is produced to a customs official. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to ensure that the copies be kept in good condition and in a secure place and any damage or loss must be reported to SAHRA immediately. Please refer to Section 21(1), 19(1), 17(1) and 18(1) of the NHRA for further details.

You are hereby given 60 (sixty) calendar days in terms of Section 21, 19(1), 17(1) of the NHRA to make written submissions or lodge objections to SAHRA. With a contractual obligation to the Fukuoka Sanix Blues in Japan until 2017, it is highly unlikely that he will take part in the Sharks' pre-season training.


He penned a two-year deal with the Durban franchise after a successful 24 months with Michael Cheika's Tahs in Sydney.

The lack of a proper pre-season programme was identified as a key contributor to the Sharks' underwhelming 2015.

Reinach feels their coaching staff are getting it right this time and his excitement was palpable when he talked about working with new assistant coach Robert du Preez. Du Preez is a former Sharks and Springbok scrumhalf.

"I have worked with Rob before when I was younger, when I needed help with my passing and some of my other scrumhalf basics. That worked out well and I know from that experience that will also work very well. The results will be seen when we come out of pre-season," Reinach said.

The pre-season has been tough so far but everything is in order. We are putting the work in and we know where we want to go. We have our goals and we'll do the best we can to achieve them."

AJAX Cape Town are desperate to get back to winning ways as they host SuperSport United in the Premier Soccer League at Athlone Stadium tomorrow (8.15pm).

Since lifting the MTN8 trophy at the end of September, Ajax have not won any of their last five matches, taking just two points from 12 in the league and enduring an early exit from the Telkom Knockout.

It is a concern for coach Roger de Sa, who saw his side also give up their year-long unbeaten run at home against Orlando Pirates last time out.

"It's another difficult match, but we need to get back to winning ways. It's been a struggle for us since the cup final for various reasons, but hopefully we can pick it up now," De Sa said.

"We have 90 percent of the team fit now so we have no excuses, we have to get going and hopefully we will put up a good performance."

Among their run was a disappointing goalless home draw against University of Pretoria in which they missed a penalty and lacked the cutting edge which had De Sa worried.

"I don't see the defeat against Pirates as being as bad as the draw against AmaTeks. When you draw

Surviving tough economy

Diversification of operations will ensure business survival

WITH recent predictions that South Africa's economic growth is set to slow even further this year, business opportunities and consumer spending will be strained.

This is especially true in light of last week's Monetary Policy Committee, which stated an unchanged interest rate, but alluded to potential rate hikes later this year.

Kobus Engelbrecht, spokesman for the Sanlam and Business Partners Entrepreneur of the Year competition, says entrepreneurs need to change their outlook when managing their business, analysing

the economic landscape and identifying opportunities in their industries.

He says they should prepare their businesses for the prolonged slow economic growth the country is experiencing.

According to the Too Slow for Too Long report, released in April by the International Monetary Fund, lower growth of 0.6% and 1.2% is expected for South Africa in 2016 and 2017, respectively.

This is below the 3% and 4% average predicted for the Sub-Saharan region during the same period.

Another aspect to consider is

that South Africa is now placed third after Nigeria and Egypt, respectively.

"Business confidence in South Africa is declining as the country grapples with the risk of a ratings downgrade to junk status and the impacts of the fluctuating rand to dollar exchange rate," says Engelbrecht.

These fluctuations increase the cost of living, and negatively impact consumers' spending power. The April 2016 Consumer Price Index (CPI) displays continued inflationary pressures, with goods and services increasing by 6.7% and 5.7% year-on-year, respectively.

So, how does all of this impact small businesses?

Engelbrecht says recent market movements have the potential to impact entrepreneurs' business prospects and outlooks.

"Slowdowns in large, dominating industries, such as the mining and manufacturing sectors, not only impact GDP, but also smaller businesses that play a supporting role in these industries."

Statistics SA reported that mining production fell by 18% year-on-year in March, down further from the 8.3% year-on-year decrease in February, and that manufacturing production declined by 2% on an annualised basis in March.

According to Engelbrecht: "These industries offer a myriad of opportunities for entrepreneurs that play primary and secondary roles in the larger supply chains, such as shops or infrastructure necessary in the area where the mines are being developed and/or redeveloped."

"As these industries' output slows, so will their need for supplier services."

"In such slow growth periods, entrepreneurs need to ensure that they are diversifying more than ever."

"Should a business have one dominant client, accounting for a large percentage of its monthly income, measures should be taken to spread income more evenly to not place the business in too much danger if they lose their main client unexpectedly."

Engelbrecht says a previous EKY competition winner was placed in this type of situation when his main client liquidated unexpectedly, forcing him to restructure his business.

While he succeeded in growing his business again by redeveloping his business model, this isn't always possible.

To avoid this, businesses should plan ahead and put back-up measures in place.

In terms of areas to diversify, he says

given the favourable exchange rate for those trading with South Africa, local entrepreneurs supporting the manufacturing sector should explore export-oriented manufacturing products.

Engelbrecht says entrepreneurs and small businesses have the potential to use their entrepreneurial skills to dominate the markets they operate in.

"Although business advisers may sound like a stuck record when reiterating that 'cash flow management is crucial to a business's success'. This element becomes important during uncertain times. Economic pressures affect demand as consumers stop spending during challenging economic periods, and this has the potential to impact business." - Business Partners Limited
